
Interior designers did what?

The photo below shows how Rambush interior decorators recreated a "Scandinavian" bedroom of the Viking age back in 1924. I have found reference to similar furnishings in Du Chaillu (see references). The friezes along the tops of the walls depict Viking ships. Perhaps this room could have been a loft, or a skemma (sleeping house). Would anyone care to check the research on this attempt, and perhaps create a set of plans for a reconstruction of this type?
