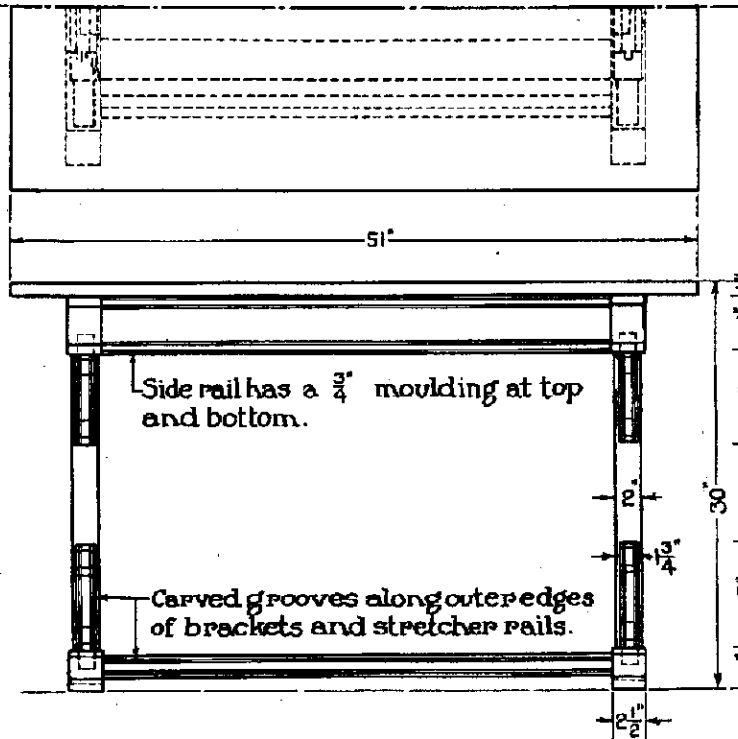


# An Elizabethan Table Project for Experienced Carpenters:

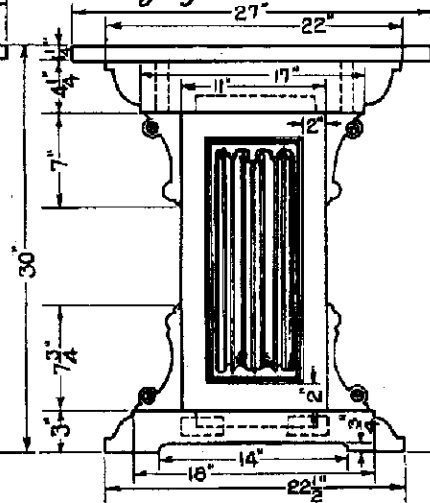


Side rail has a  $\frac{3}{4}$ " moulding at top and bottom.

Carved grooves along outer edges of brackets and stretcher rails.



Detail of carved rosettes on the end brackets. They are carved on both the inside and outside of brackets. Table is constructed of mahogany and finished dark.



Library table adapted from the Elizabethan style. The linen fold decoration is carved on both the inside and outside of the end panels. This decoration is a typical feature of woodwork of the time of Henry VIII.
